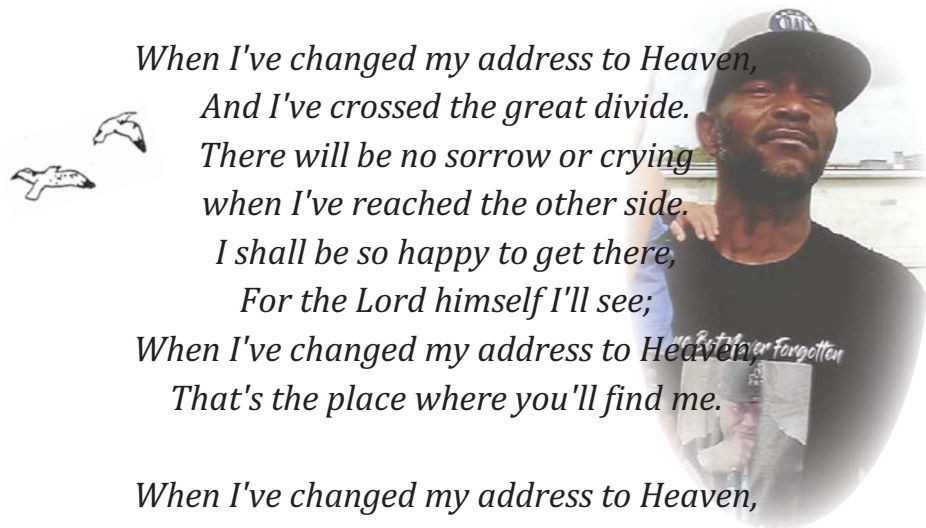

That's the place where you'll find me.

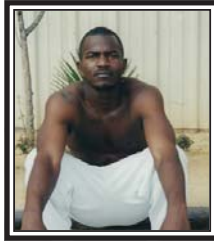
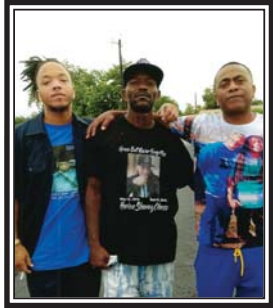
I'm Free
