When I had my son there you were again. Being in the place of my mother to guide, support and show me the way. You took my son in as a grandson of your own and loved and spoiled him dearly.


You were my strength when I was weak. You helped me keep my Faith and Trust in God when things were heavy for me. You prayed for us when it was hard for us to Pray for ourselves.


