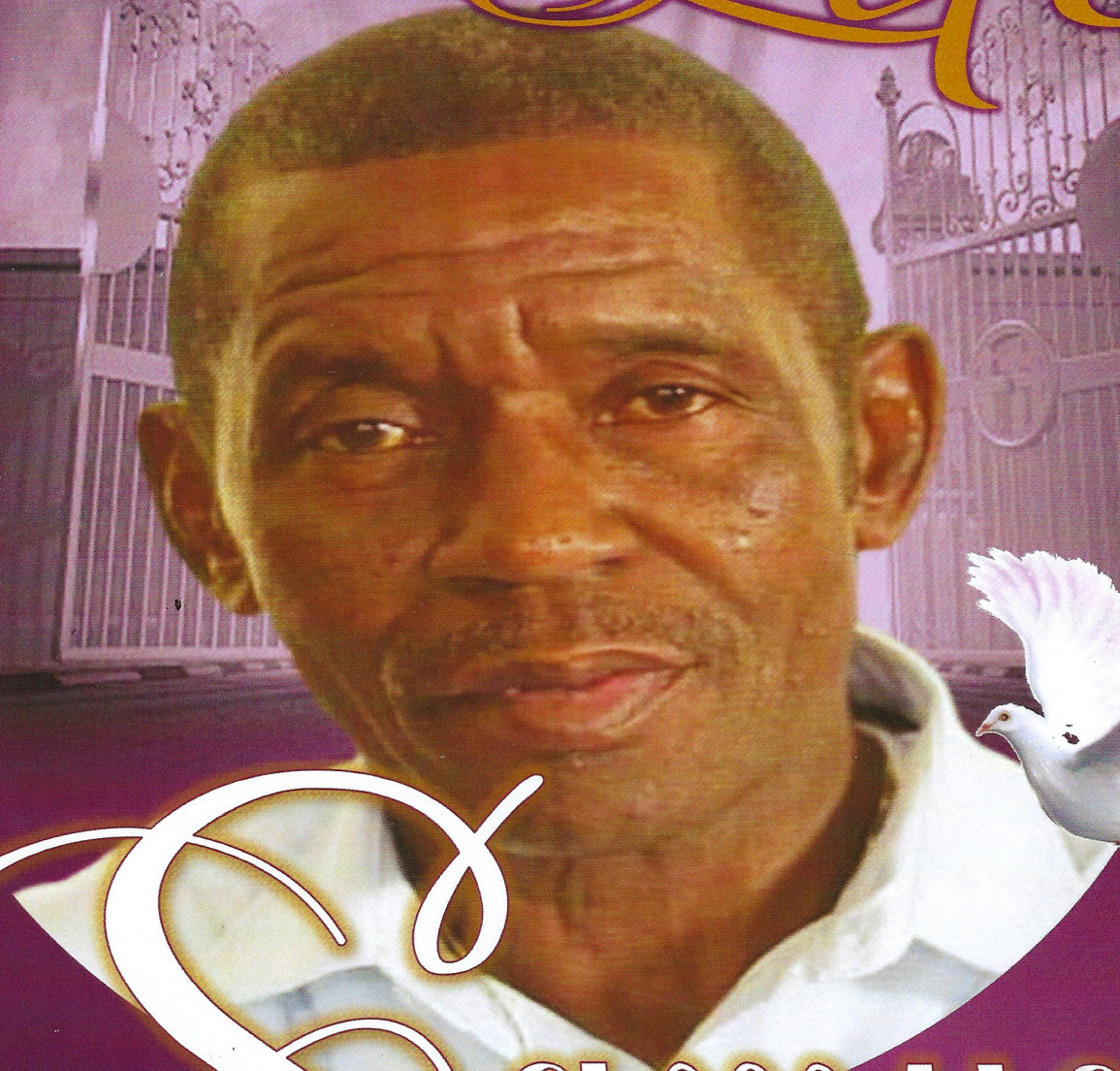

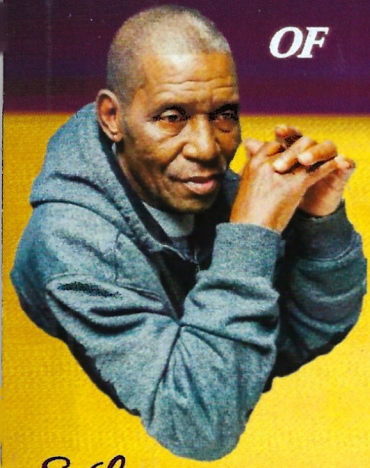

S.L. was baptized at an early age at Second Pleasant Grove Baptist Church of Harvey, La by Rev. Cole.

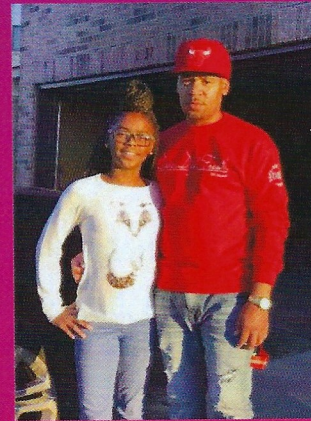
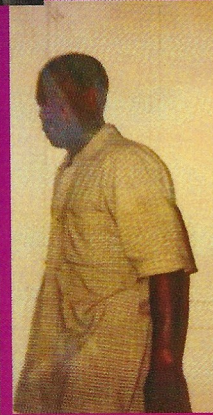
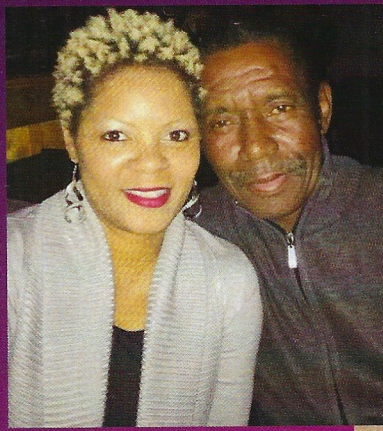

Upon a gentle breeze

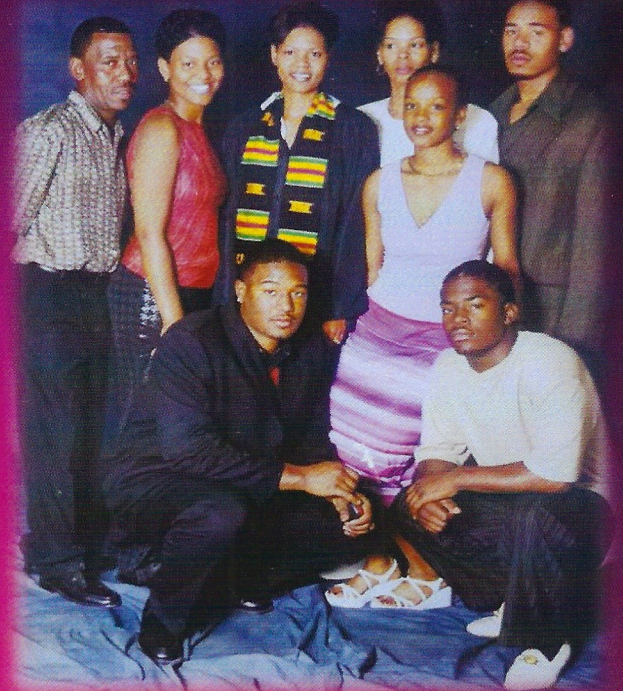
I still see our face in places
