William's Journey of Life

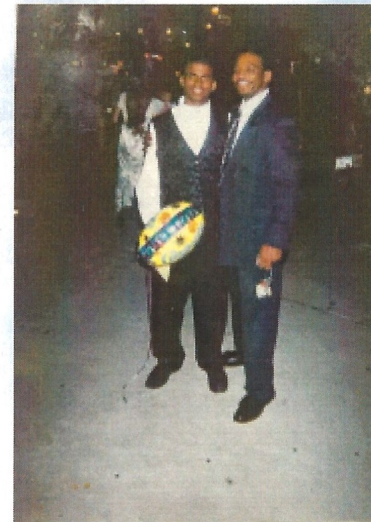
