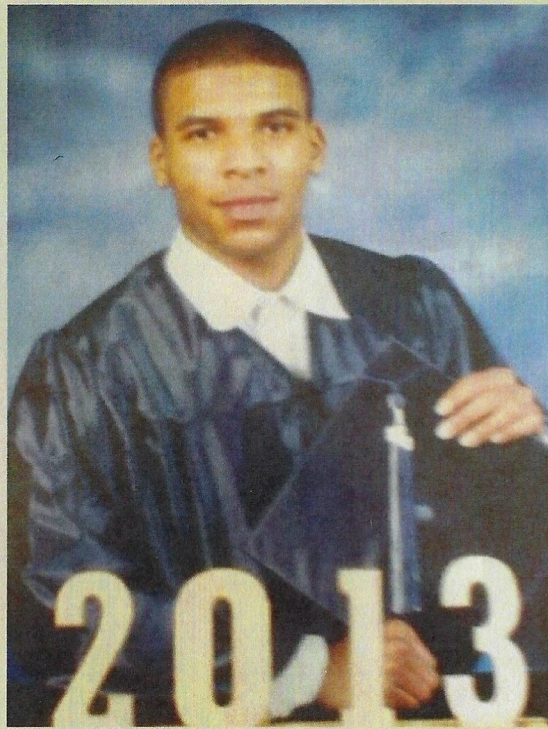

know.”*

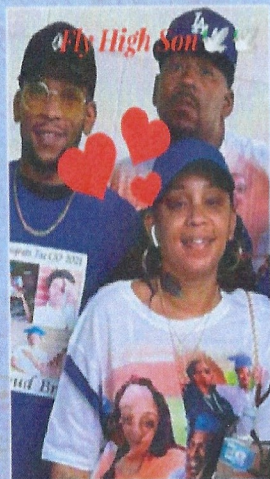
