Eva didn't have a favorite color she liked all colors. The world and its colors were beautiful to Eva.

Eva's greatest testimony was 3 years ago when she got tired and wanted to change her life, which she did basically on her own. She is a true example that you can be delivered if you want to be.

Eva moved to Dallas, Texas to help take care of her mom. While living in Dallas she found out she had cancer.

After receiving the news of having cancer, Eva was her own best cheerleader; never crying or complaining or asking why me. She would always say sister (*Veronica*) you said God is in control and he has the final say, that the doctors must do their job and give the patients the diagnoses of their condition.

I know that's where you'll be*

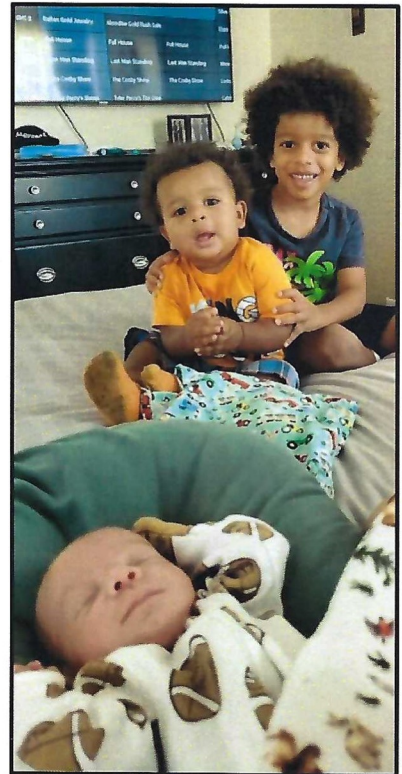
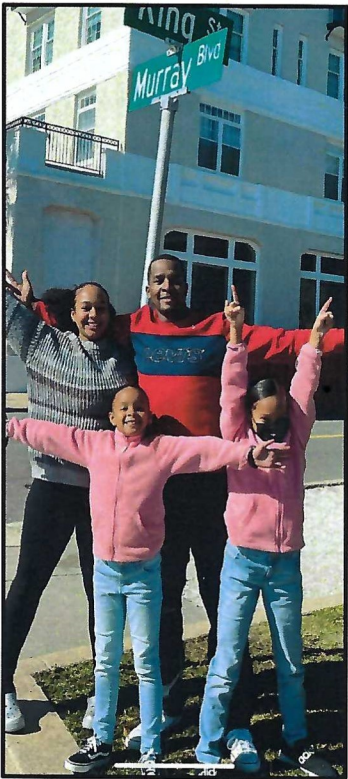
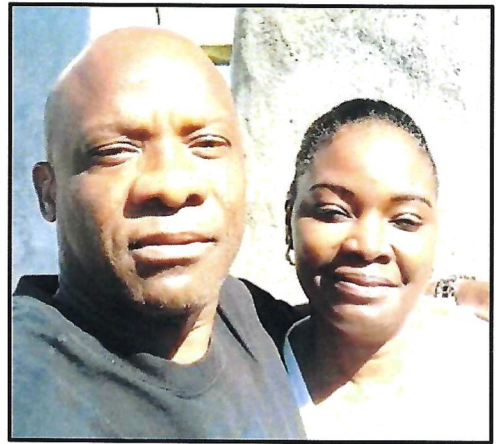
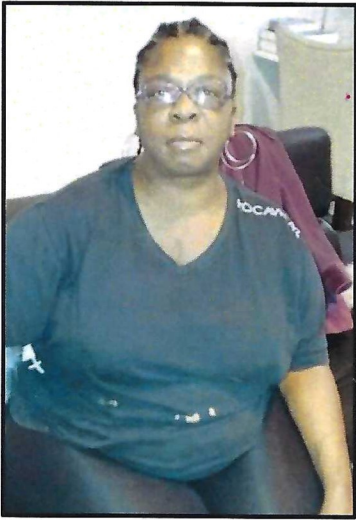

and only God knows why.*

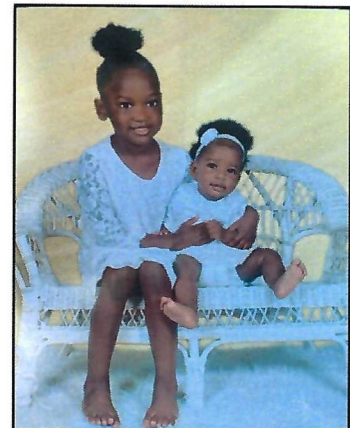
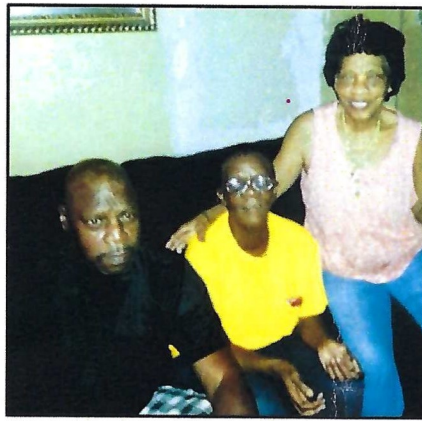

is where you'll always stay.*



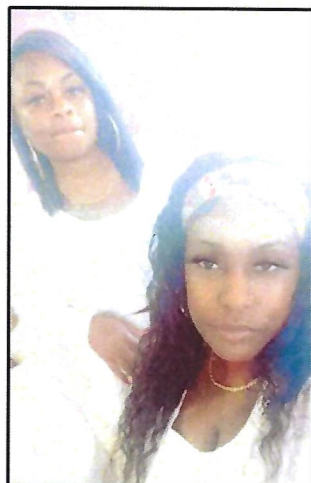

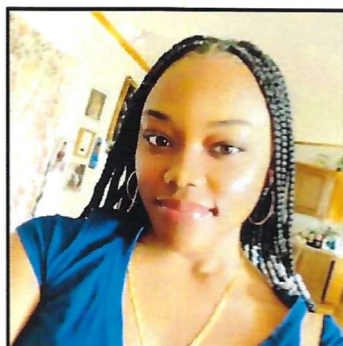
Our Eva Diva,
