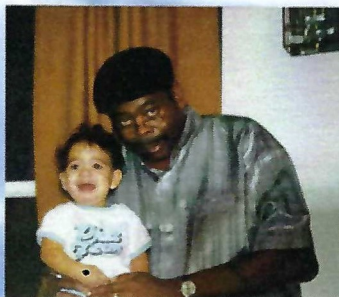
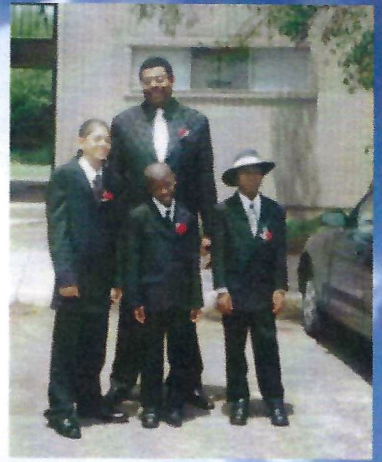
Obituary


