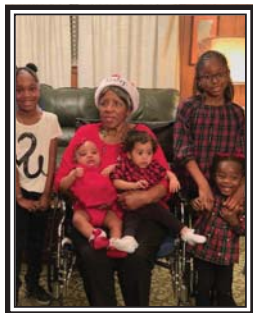
Life's Journey
