# Her Story

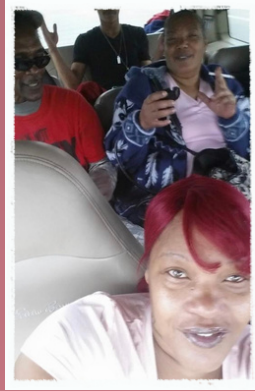
