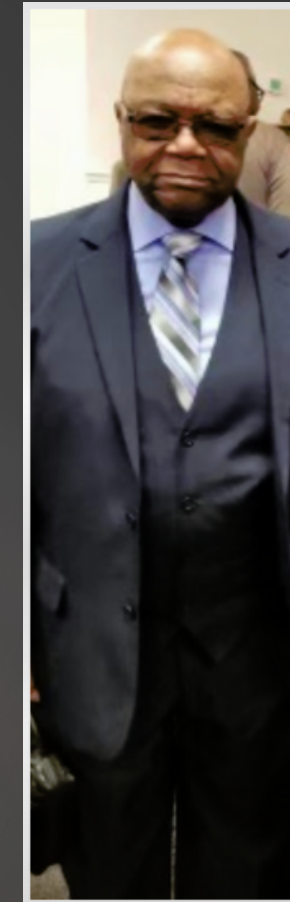
*He Is Your Keeper,
