Priscilla married David P. Longoria on April 8, 1998.

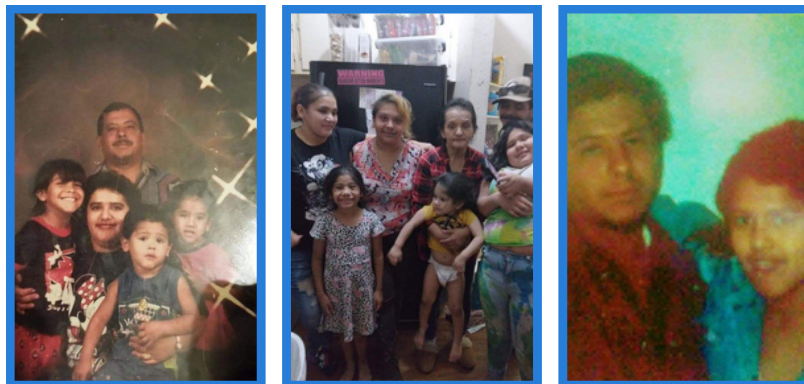
