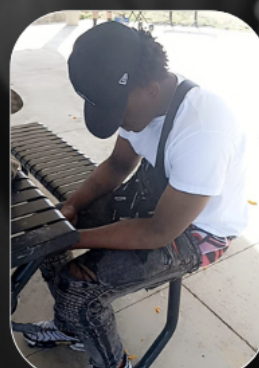
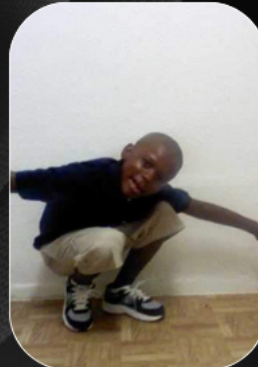


AUBREY'S *Life*
