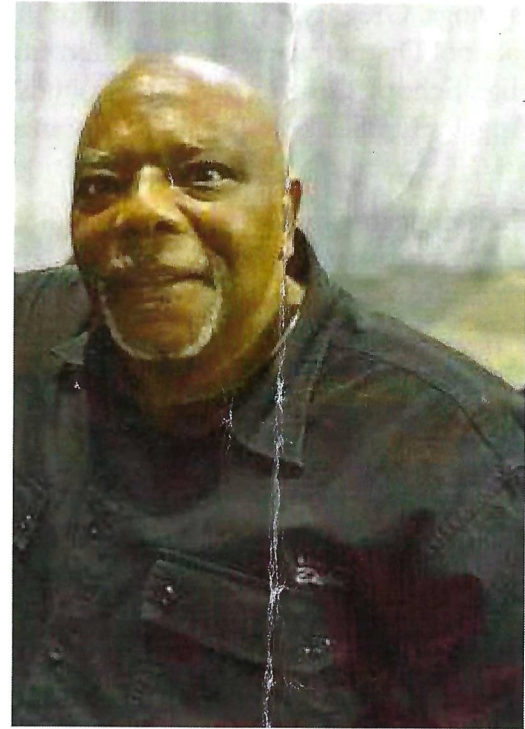


Gregory B. Goodin
