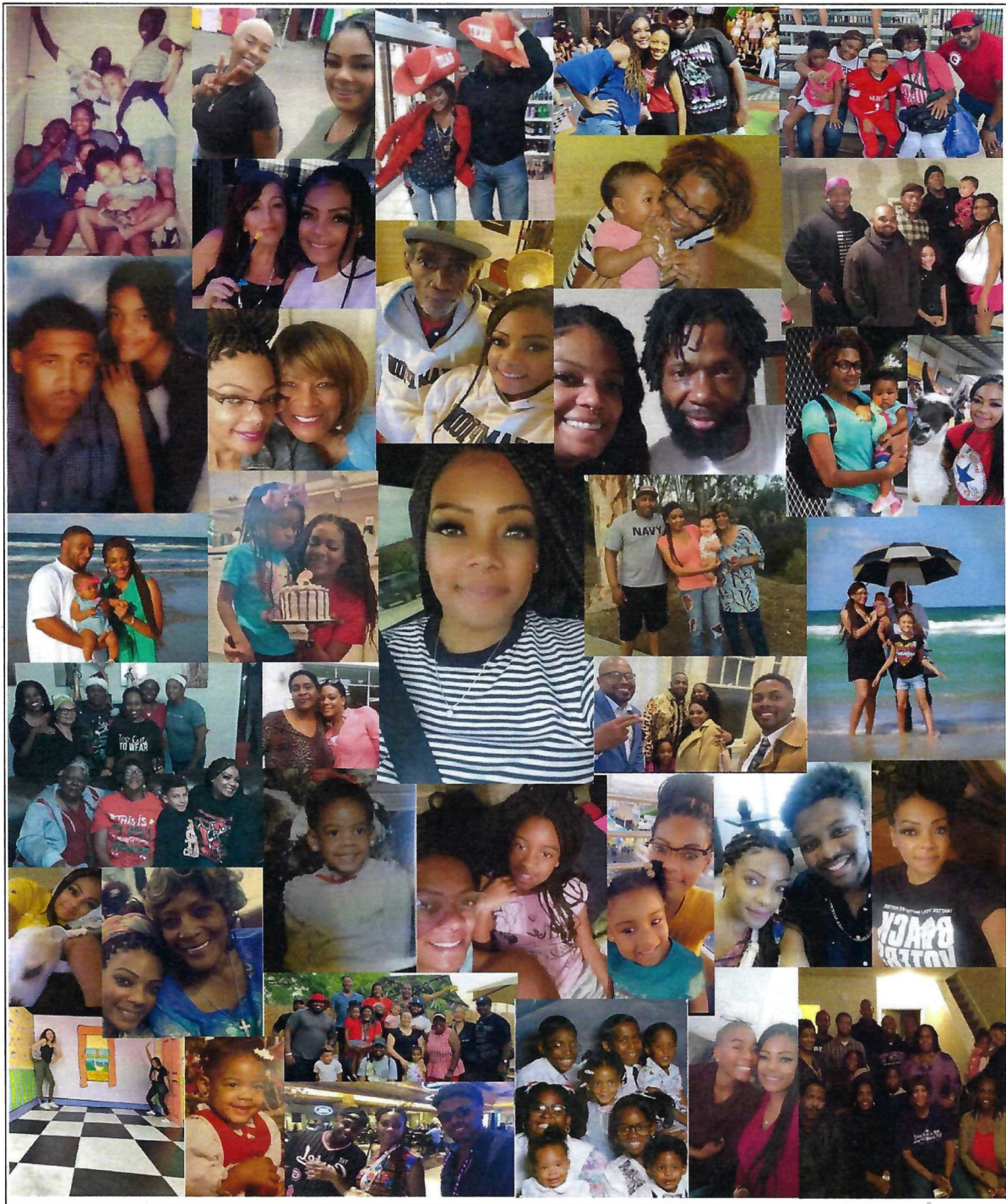
She shared one daughter, Khloe Franklin, with Ernest Franklin. She was a loving and devoted mom, always doing what she could to create memories and provide for Khloe.
