Khadija Derry, born on November 6, 2001, in San Antonio, Texas, passed away on December 6, 2023. Khadija was the beloved daughter of George Sullivan and Kuquanda Perkins. She accepted Christ at an early age and was an active member of Lilly of the Valley Missionary Baptist Church, where she played an integral role in the youth department.

Khadija attended SJ Davis and Sam Houston schools within the San Antonio Independent School District (SAISD). Throughout her academic journey, Khadija excelled in various sports, including volleyball, track, and basketball. She left a lasting impression on the basketball court, giving her all and holding the fastest time in the SAISD middle school for the 100-meter dash. Khadija's exceptional skills on the court led to a full basketball scholarship at Iowa Western College. At the time of her passing, she was attending Northeast Lakeview College.

Khadija's accolades in sports were numerous, including being named Newcomer of the Year in 2016-2017, MVP and All-Area Team in 2017-2018, and Defensive Player of the Year in 2018-2019 and 2019-2020. She was part of various All-Tournament teams such as Edgewood, Harlandale, and New Braunfels. Moreover, Khadija achieved a significant milestone by scoring over 1000 career points.

Her love for sports blossomed at an early age, participating in various athletic activities at the Eastside Boys & Girls Club. Influenced by her talent, her aunt Trice established the Lady Ballers basketball team, which evolved from a little league to a thriving AAU team, winning several out-of-state tournaments. Khadija also played AAU basketball for Texas Flight under the guidance of her uncle Steven, and she showcased her skills as a track athlete for the San Antonio Blazers. Additionally, she had a passion for shoes and dreamt of traveling the world. Khadija will be remembered for her beautiful, infectious smile that lit up any room.

She was preceded in death by her grandfather George Shandy, great grandparents Elvira M. Perkins, Mable & Arthur Hardaway, Lee Mathews, and Gloria Nelson, as well as her godmother Eva Taylor, aunt Beretta Franklin, and best friend Aujayna Williams.

Khadija's memories will forever be cherished by her parents George Sullivan and KuQuanda Perkins (Jason), grandparents Stephanie Perkins, Shelia Shandy, Arthur Hardaway Jr. (Genia), and Darryl Nelson, great grandparents Denise Matthews and Lawrence Sullivan, and her siblings Dejanique (Myron), Journee, Jauan "Smurf", Jakiyah, and Mykira, along with eight step-siblings. She was also loved by her bonus mom April Butler-Sullivan, godfather Corliss Taylor, and honorary godmother Nannie Shawn.

She is survived by her great uncle George Matthews (Dorothy), great aunt Lois Matthews, nieces MyAejah and Myzi, nephew Myron, and aunts Antrecia (Methis), Dewana (Matt), Angie (Jabari), and Tenise. 




Khadija:
