I think of you in silence, I often SPEAK your NAME.

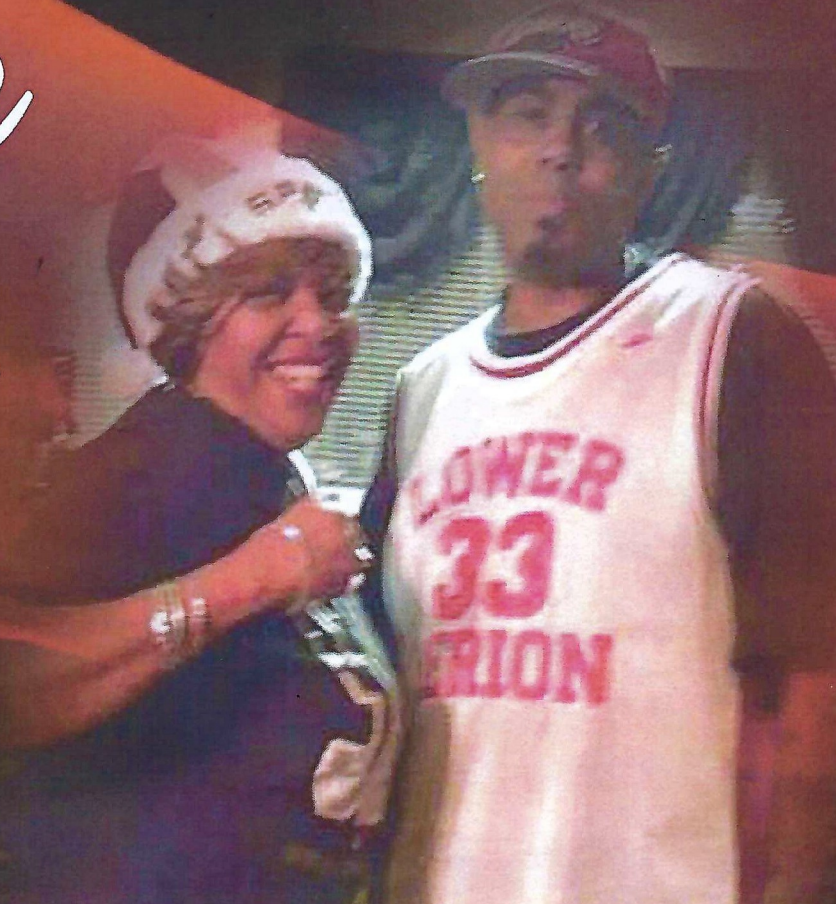
All I have are Memories and your pictures in a frame.

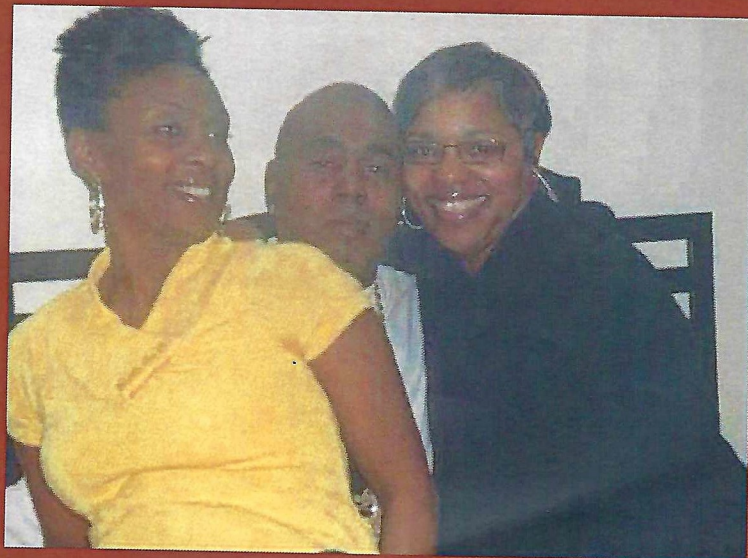
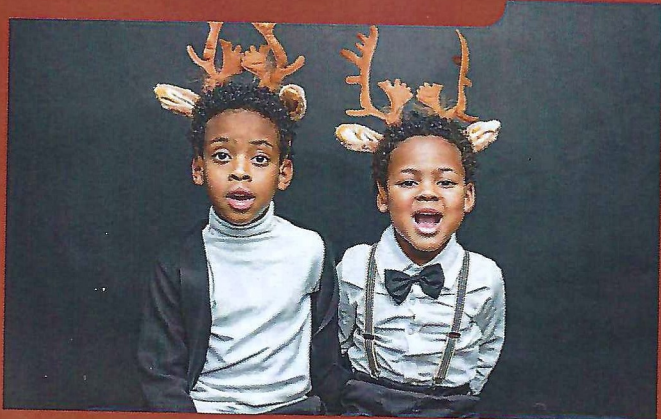
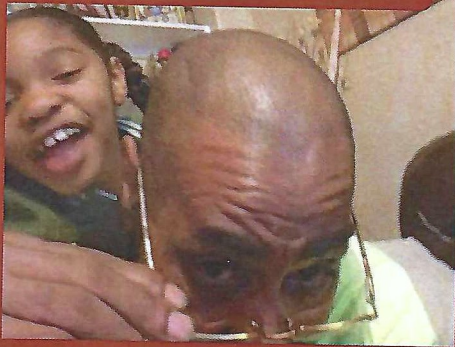
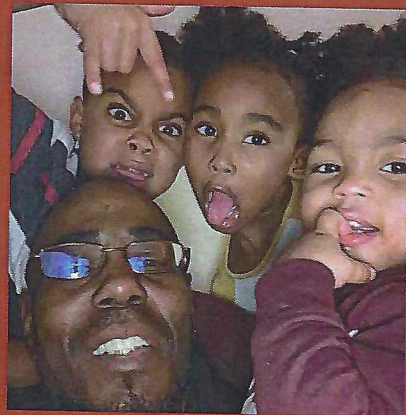
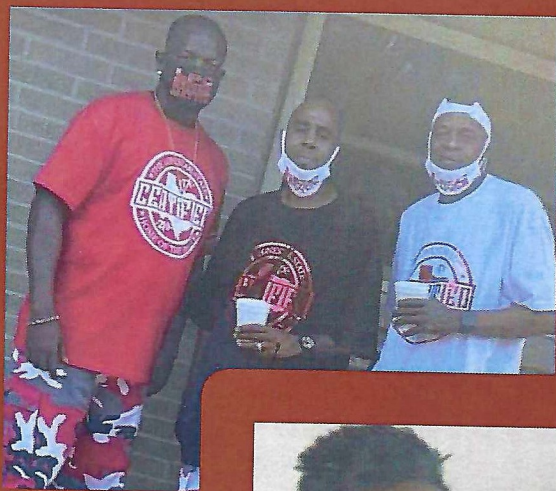
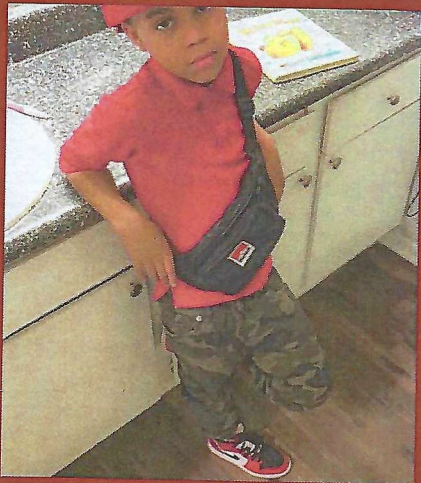
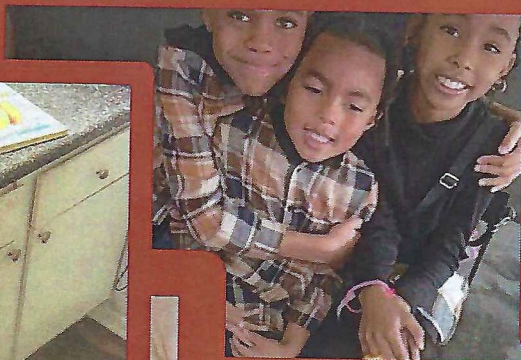


You held my hand when i was small you caught me when I fell
