Ah yes, these things I too shall miss.

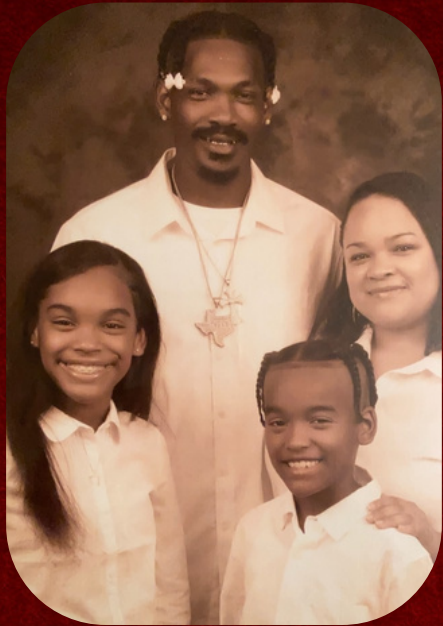
Be not burdened with times of sorrow:

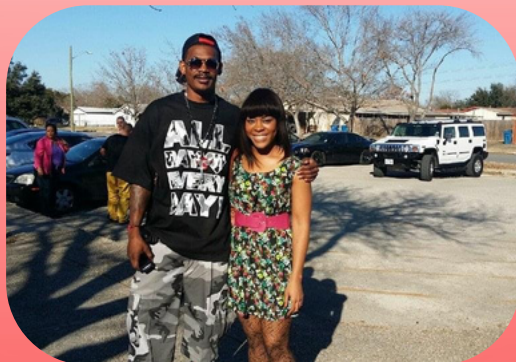
